The organization works towards this vision by enabling education for underserved children, building employability skills among youth, promoting women empowerment, and supporting health, nutrition, and environmental initiatives. At its core, Amarpushp is committed to developing scalable and impact-driven programs aligned with national development priorities. Its work is guided by strong values of inclusion, integrity, empowerment, collaboration, and a clear focus on measurable outcomes.

Established in 2011, Amarpushp has grown from a grassroots initiative into a structured development organization with a presence across the NCR region and Uttar Pradesh. Over the years, it has focused on addressing critical gaps in foundational education, digital and employability skills, and access to community support systems. Its flagship initiatives, Shiksha Pratham and the Amarpushp Skill Academy, reflect its integrated approach towards education and livelihoods. The organization has also strengthened its internal systems, including program implementation, monitoring and evaluation, financial governance, and CSR compliance, enabling it to deliver consistent and accountable impact.

Amarpushp is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and holds key certifications such as 12A, 80G, and CSR-1, making it eligible for tax exemptions and CSR partnerships. The organization follows a robust governance framework supported by regular financial audits, transparent reporting practices, and adherence to statutory and compliance norms, ensuring credibility and trust among stakeholders.

Context & Need

While India has made notable progress in expanding access to education and livelihood opportunities, deep-rooted inequities continue to persist at the last mile. Recognizing these interconnected challenges, Amarpushp started operating in Prayagraj and Noida with an integrated approach combining of Education, Skill Development, Women Empowerment, Health and Community Support, Environmental Initiatives This holistic model ensures that individuals are not only supported in the present but are also equipped for a more secure and self-reliant future.

In **Noida's urban and peri-urban clusters**, a large proportion of families are migrant workers engaged in informal labour. Frequent mobility, unstable incomes, and limited social security systems disrupt children's education continuity. Although school enrolment rates are relatively high, **learning outcomes remain critically low**, with many children in early grades unable to read basic texts or perform simple arithmetic. Overcrowded government schools and lack of supplementary academic support further widen these foundational learning gaps, increasing the risk of long-term educational exclusion.

In **Prayagraj's semi-urban and rural communities**, the challenge is compounded by **limited access to quality education infrastructure**, lower parental literacy levels, and socio-economic vulnerabilities. First-generation learners often lack academic support at home, resulting in poor retention, low confidence, and gradual disengagement from formal education systems.

Parallely, across both geographies, youth **face a significant employability crisis**. Despite completing basic schooling, many young individuals remain unprepared for the job market due to:

- Minimal exposure to **digital tools and technology**
- Lack of **communication and workplace readiness skills**
- Absence of **structured career pathways and job linkages**

This creates a **systemic disconnect between education and employment**, pushing youth into informal, low-paying, and unstable work, thereby perpetuating cycles of poverty.

Women and girls in these communities face **additional barriers**, including restricted mobility, limited access to skill development opportunities, and socio-cultural constraints that hinder their economic participation.

Furthermore, **inadequate access to healthcare, nutrition, and awareness services** continues to impact overall well-being, directly influencing education continuity, productivity, and quality of life.

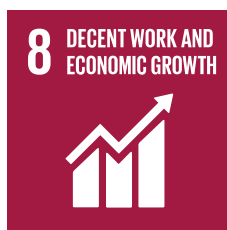

The organization follows a **holistic development approach**, ensuring that individuals are supported at every stage—from early learning to livelihood generation.

Shiksha Pratham

Foundational Learning Program under “Education Initiatives” Shiksha Pratham is the flagship education initiative of Amarpushp, focused on strengthening **foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN)** among children from underserved communities.

The program primarily supports **first-generation learners** studying in government schools, who often lack access to academic support at home.

Key Interventions:

- Structured after-school academic support
- Focus on reading, writing, and basic numeracy skills
- Small-group learning for personalized attention
- Continuous assessment and remedial support
- Engagement with parents to support children’s learning

Impact Focus:

- Improved learning outcomes and academic confidence
- Increased school attendance and participation
- Reduced risk of dropout among vulnerable children

Through Shiksha Pratham, Amarpushp is working to ensure that **education translates into real learning**, laying a strong foundation for future growth.



Amarpushp Skill Academy

Digital & Employability Skills under Skill Development & Livelihood Programs

Amarpushp Skill Academy focuses on preparing youth for **sustainable livelihood opportunities** by equipping them with industry-relevant skills. The program addresses the critical gap between **education and employability**, particularly for youth from economically weaker backgrounds.
